Grass clippings, bagged leaves, brush
Household metal goods
Lawn mowers (gas removed)
Luggage
Mattresses
Metal tire rims
Microwaves
Pallets
Pressure Tanks

Sinks
Snowblowers (gas removed)
Stoves & ranges
Tires (4 per permit)
Tools
Toys
Treadmills
TV's / computers / electronics
Water heaters / furnaces

- \$20 per car (cash only) * NO COMMERCIAL DUMPING
- 2 permits per household
- ID with proof of residence required at permit purchase and at drop-off location
- Permits can be purchased at the Town Clerk's office: 110 Bracken Rd. before Fri. Oct 18th **OR** at the time of drop-off
- Cars are allowed 3 loads per permit: pick-up trucks are allowed 2 loads per permit: larger vehicles allowed 1 load per permit
